Joe Russell has turned professional fighter. He used to practice so much in grade school that he's really got a good career going.

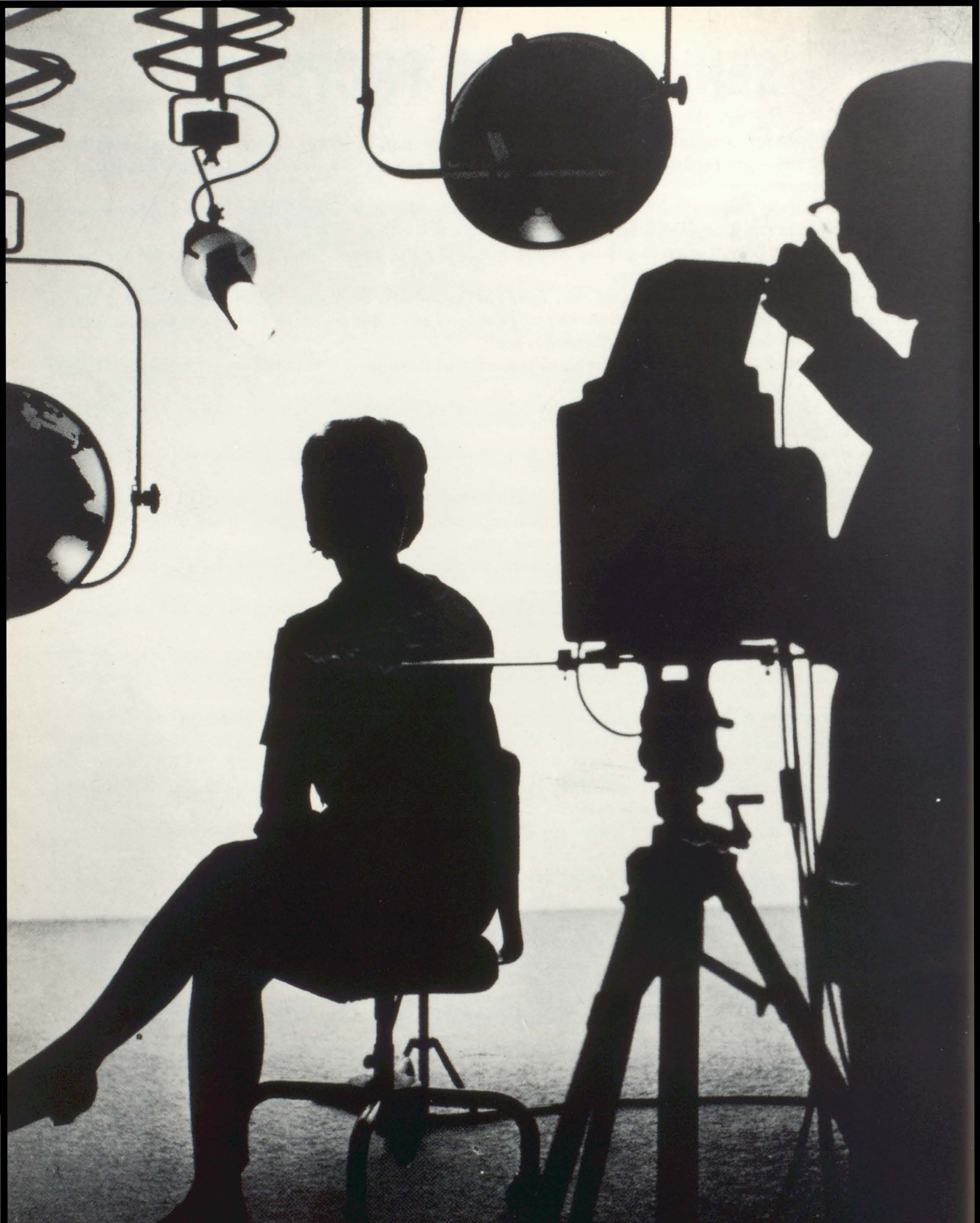
