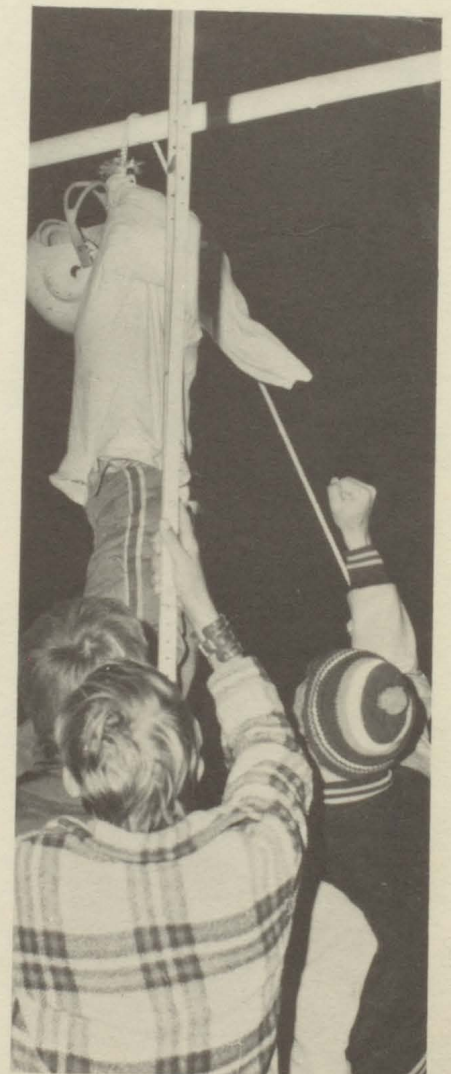
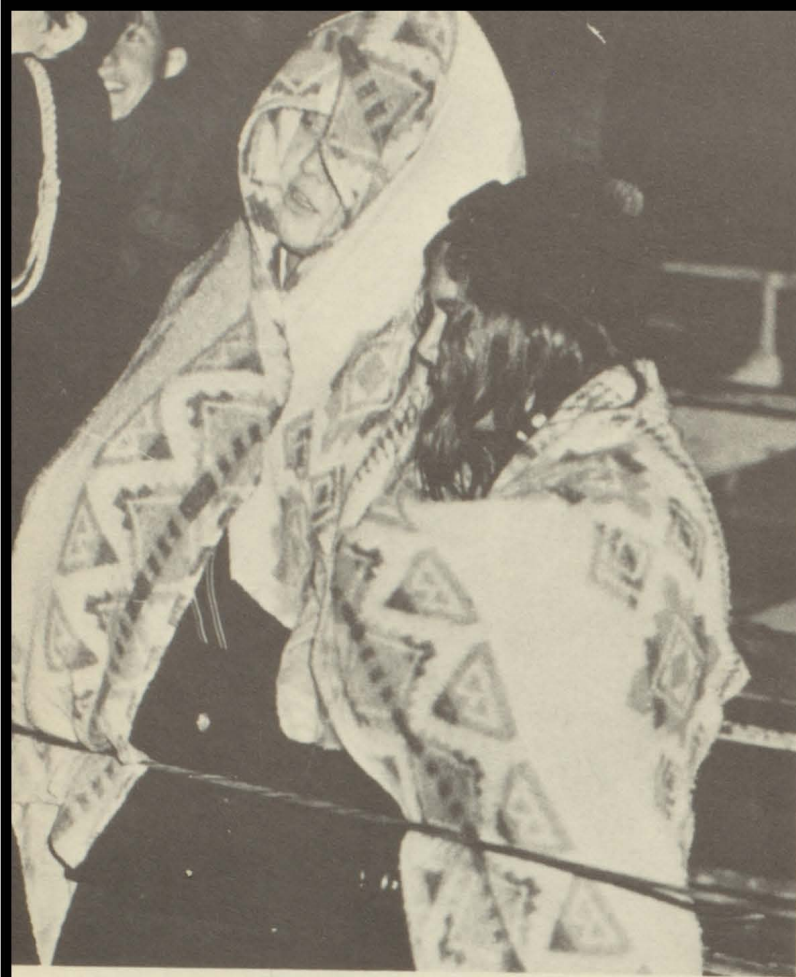
# Homecoming

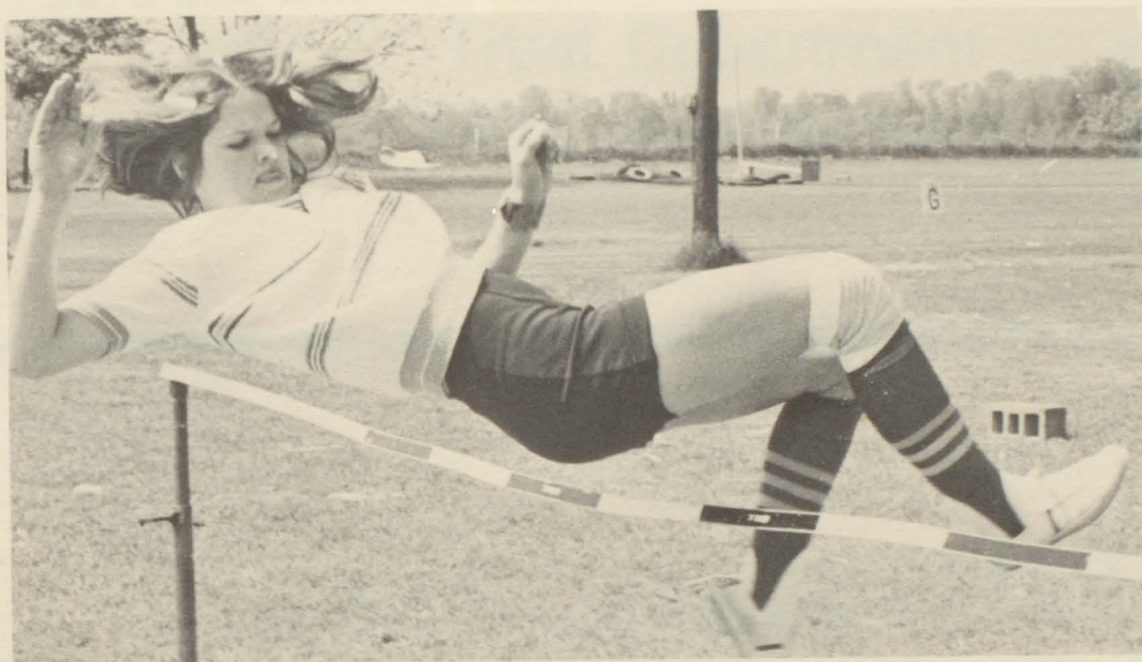
