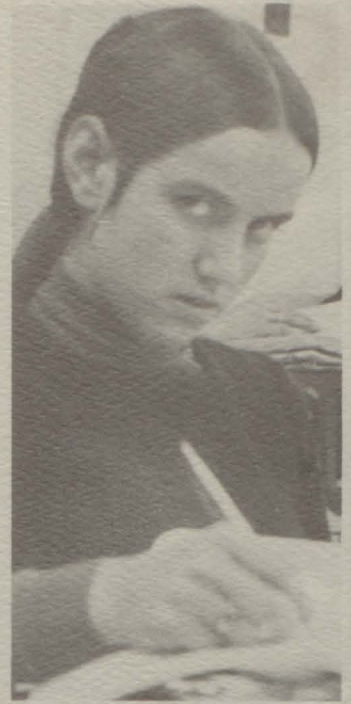
Chemistry is a course that shows how things are made and why they react the way they do. It is a hard but interesting course when you get in the hang of things.

'72 was not a winning season for the Mustang FB Team. At least not in the usual sense--of what the records will show.

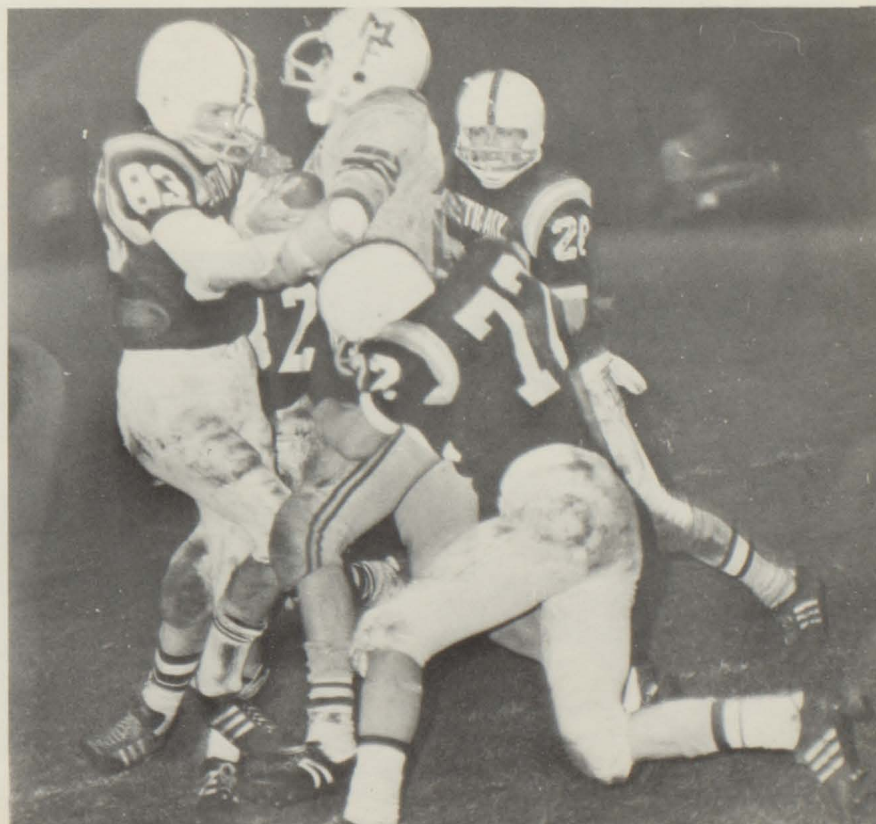
But the records don't tell the winning side--it's the reality of sports that any athlete knows: the growth, the fierce friendships and competition.

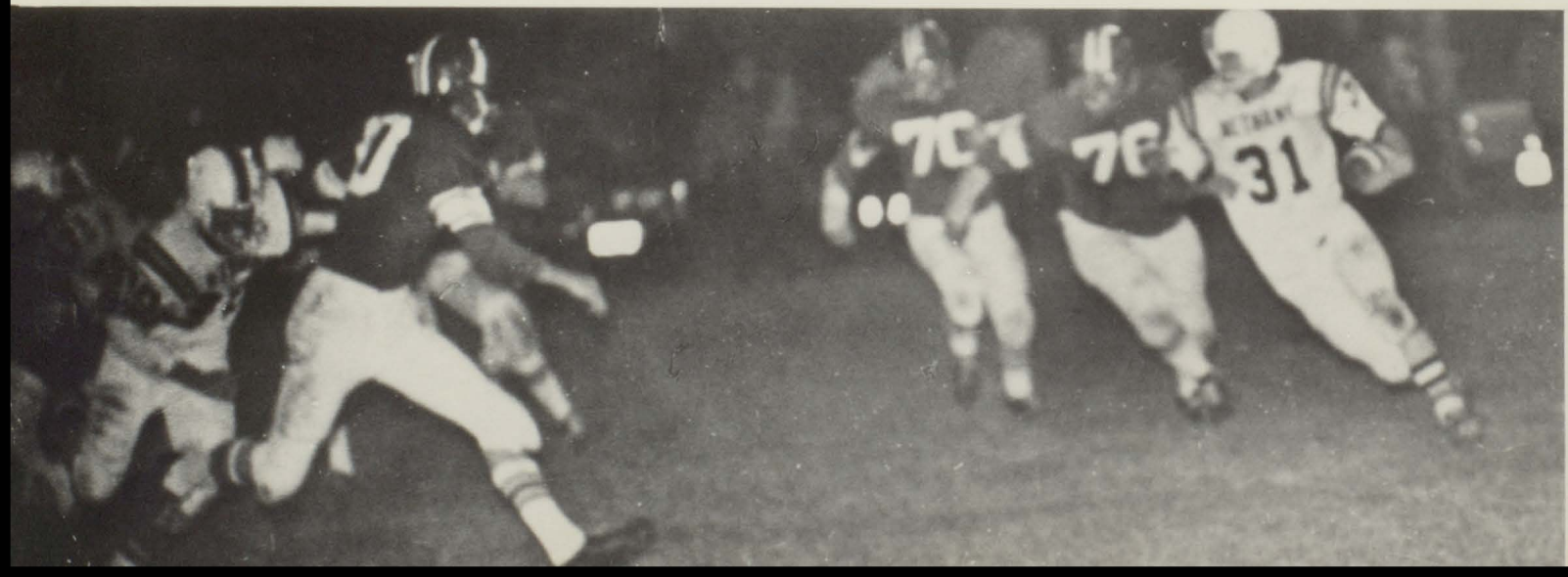

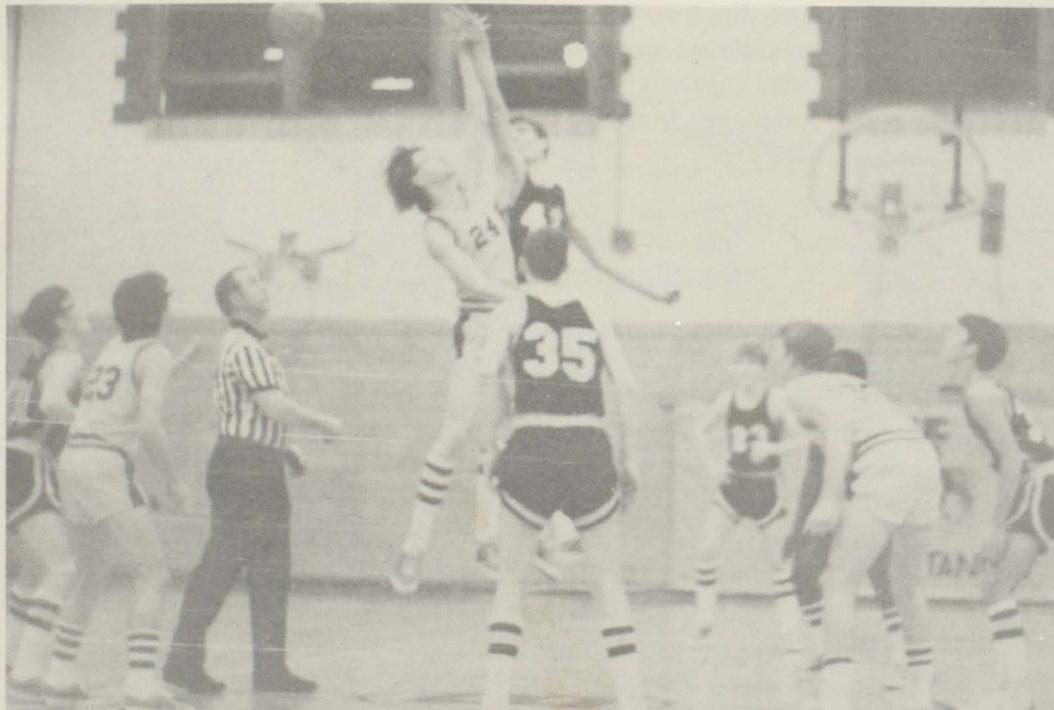

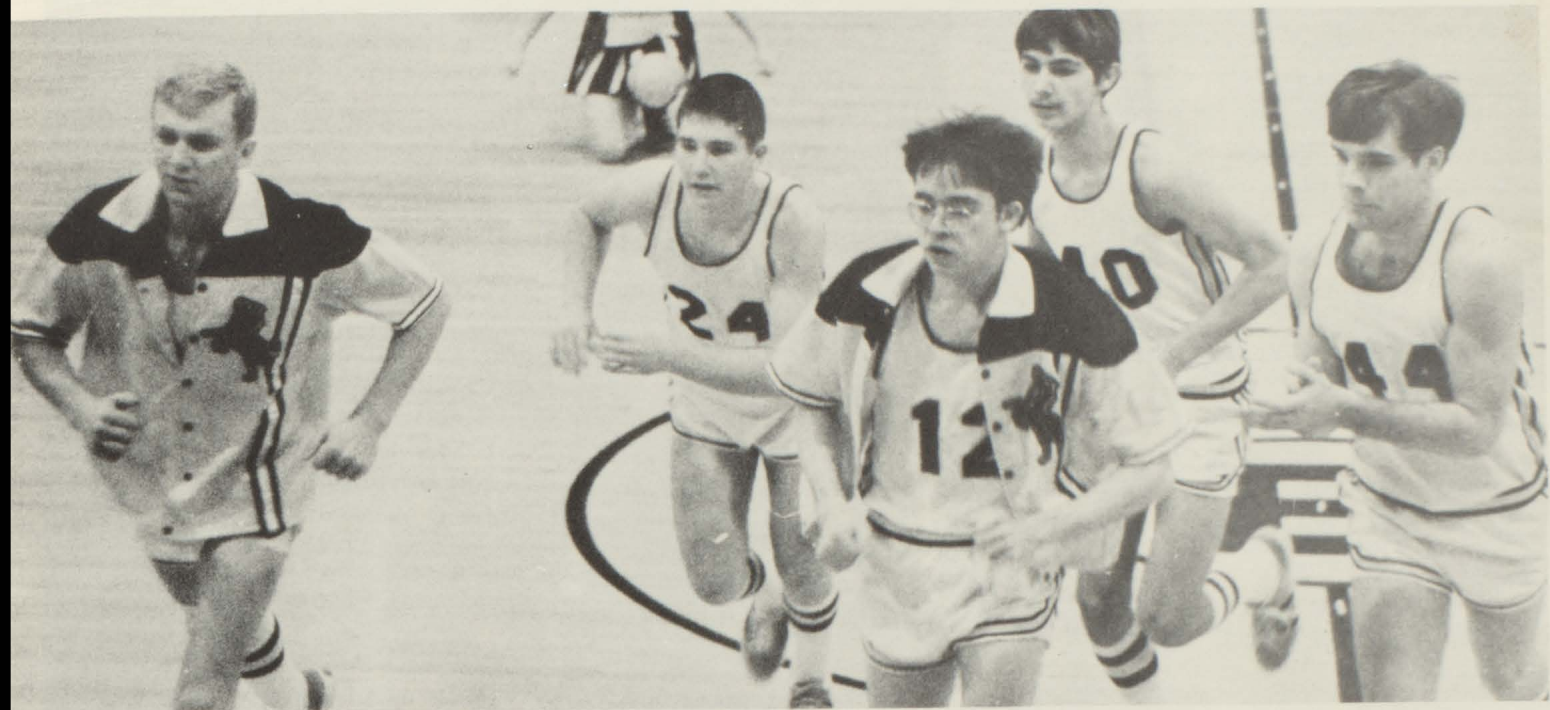

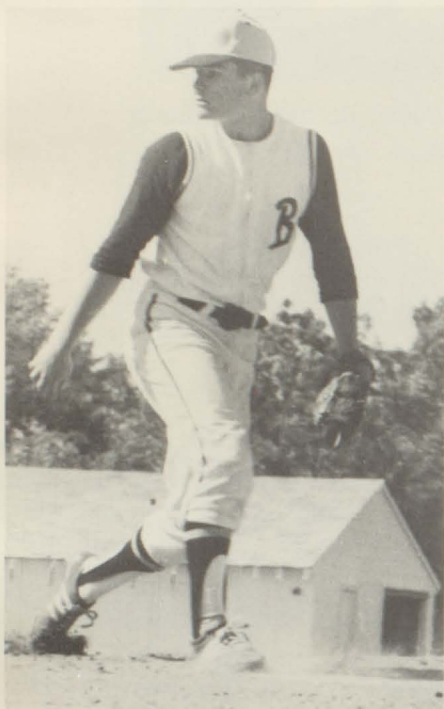
